Within a decade there were already three of them, with a well-known Spanish sealant producer being acquired.

Our adhesives are characterised by fast adhesion and a strong bond. The focus of development is on environmentally friendly products and new application methods.

PENOSIL foam is widely used in stagecraft decorations and foam sculptures because it is easy to process and model. Students in the Sculpture and Installation, Jewellery and Blacksmith Departments of the Estonian Academy of Arts use construction foam on a daily basis to prepare three-dimensional sculptures. Over the years, polar bears, stalactites, puppets and famous public figures have been produced from the foam. These can be found in museums, theatres, urban spaces and family adventure parks.

An original 3.8-metre foam sculpture of the famous Baltic ballerina Kaie Kõrb is on permanent display at the Wolf Group's headquarters. Sculptor Maigi Magnus said that she was inspired by Kõrb's movement, which is as graceful as it is powerful.

PENOSIL's achievements in design competitions are evidence of the success of its tool design. In 2011, the brand won the Design Applier award for its EasyGun construction foam applicator. EasyGun is a successful replacement for the traditional foam gun which makes it possible to dose the construction foam precisely and to use it sparingly. Almost 6,000,000 EasyGun applicators have been sold to date.

In 2018 the EasyPRO Spatula reached the final round of the Estonian Association of Designers competition in the Engineering/Technical Product category. Previously, clients had had to use a moist finger or an additional tool to smooth joints, but the sealant now comes with a spatula that produces an even result across the entire joint.



The key areas of PENOSIL's responsibility are safety, a good user experience, environmental responsibility and corporate social responsibility. These are based on our mission and vision. The PENOSIL brand has supported initiatives that are aimed at solving key social problems in less fortunate areas. We stand globally for the well-being of children and youngsters.
